Course overview

The VTCT Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing (QCF) is a substantial vocational qualification for learners seeking a career as an employed and / or self-employed junior hairdresser / stylist.

This qualification is based on the Level 2 Hairdressing National Occupational Standards (NOS) and is recognised by the UK's lead hairdressing professional association (The Hairdressing Council) as being fit for purpose for preparing learners for a career as a junior hairdresser / stylist.

This qualification has been specifically designed for the 16 - 19 year age group and will prepare learners for employment as a junior hairdresser / stylist. Learners will work in and have their hairdressing skills assessed in a 'real' commercial salon. This qualification includes all the required elements to work effectively as a junior hairdresser / stylist.

Learners will also develop their understanding and skills by selecting a number of optional specialist units.
